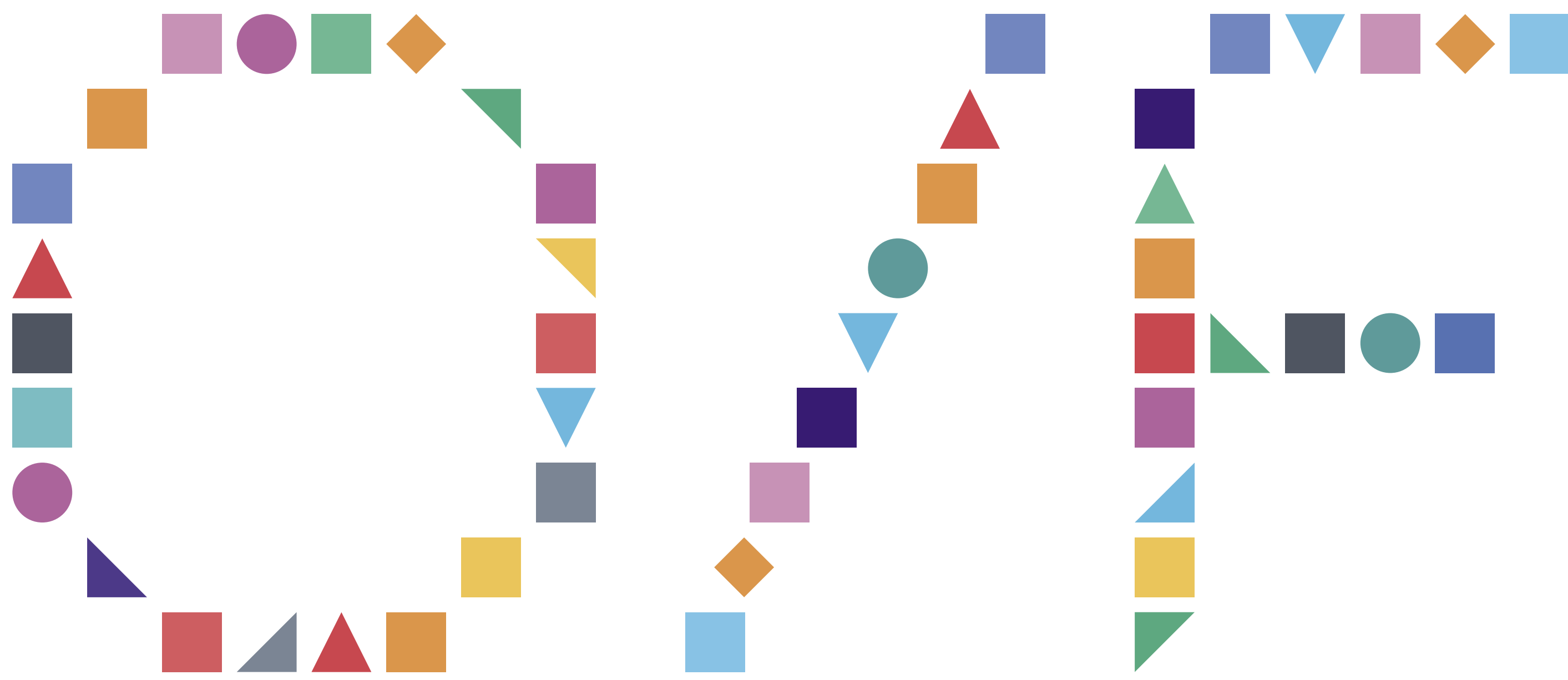


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OPEN- FURNISHINGS

#Openfurnishings is a manifesto on self-produced furniture, open production, shared knowledge, and shared and responsible use of resources, which plans information to make seating systems available.

The project is inspired by Enzo Mari's vision to empower people by encouraging them to realize furniture with their own hands so that they can have a critical vision of the product by building it and thus implementing a process that enhances intelligence and talent of the project community. On the other hand, the access that we have today to technology gives us the opportunity to use production processes previously unattainable outside of the industry. The furniture projects deriving from this initiative must be able to be produced by the user, within the city, using the resources of a local digital production laboratory with 3D printers and CNC cutting machines.

The main features of the project are based on the universality of users, the ability to transport goods, the simplicity of construction and the availability of materials. Based on the principles of open design, people develop and share knowledge, generating projects that are freely available on the web to be shared, improved, modified, manufactured and so on.

Development and design are based on the use of resources, but with global techniques and tools adapted to their particular

characteristics (cultural, social, material, etc.). Hence, the design is downloadable and editable by the user himself. Openfurnishings aims to empower citizens as agents of transformation, putting technology at their service and privileging local production with local resources, generating dynamic and productive cities, looking to the future from an ecological perspective and trying to minimize carbon emissions. Openfurnishings is an initiative in continuous evolution and from 2021 it will evolve in order to realize as faithfully as possible the premises mentioned above. This is a project organized by the University of Ferrara in the Degree Course in Industrial Design curated by professors Dario Scodeller, Ivano Vianello and Laura Bortoloni. The intent is to create a community in which students of design courses from different universities interact on the creation of instructions for new seats and other accessories that will be made available to end-users.

This design community will also aim to gather useful information for the new design thanks to end-users' feedbacks.

Openfurnishings is a manifesto about open production and shared knowledge, inspired by Enzo Mari vision of "autoprogettazione"

Twelve outdoor sitting solutions, designed by the students of "Design del Prodotto Industriale" course of Università degli Studi di Ferrara, showcased along with the instructions on how to build them.

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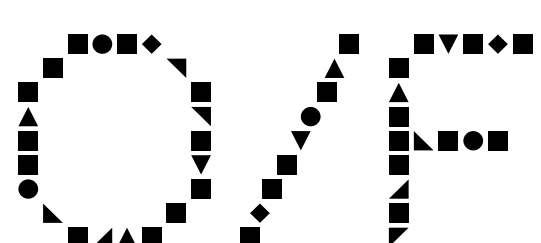
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
